


General

New features in the parts catalogue




Re-introduction of the REACH icon, now connected to SURE (sure.scania.com/reach).




When you click on the link to SURE, you will be taken to the homepage of the site. Select "Other products" in the drop-down menu in the illustration above.






The field to the right is then activated, allowing the part number to be entered.




Fill in the relevant part number and click "Search". Information about the part is displayed in the window to the right of the illustration.



New features for BBMQA report




Drop-down menu under the "Country" field with selectable markets to make it easier for the user.



After selecting a market, select a workshop using the drop-down menu under the "Workshop" field.






Finally, select the bus bodybuilder in the field under "Bodybuilder".

This issue is the last with updated maintenance forms for periodic maintenance. There are no planned changes, adjustments or additions for these.


The forms for flexible maintenance will be removed from Multi and will then only be available in SWS (Scania Workshop Suite) where they are already available today. This is because the workshop must be connected in order to handle flexible maintenance.

New information type – electrical diagram



A new information type has been introduced – electrical diagram.





These electrical diagrams are automatically filtered for the relevant chassis using information from source databases.
